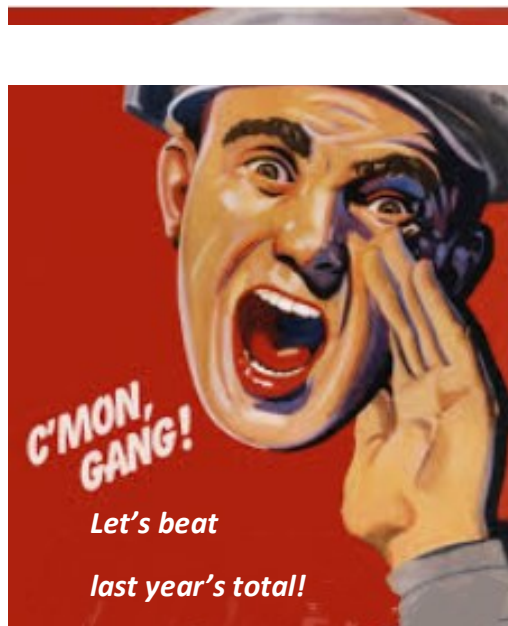

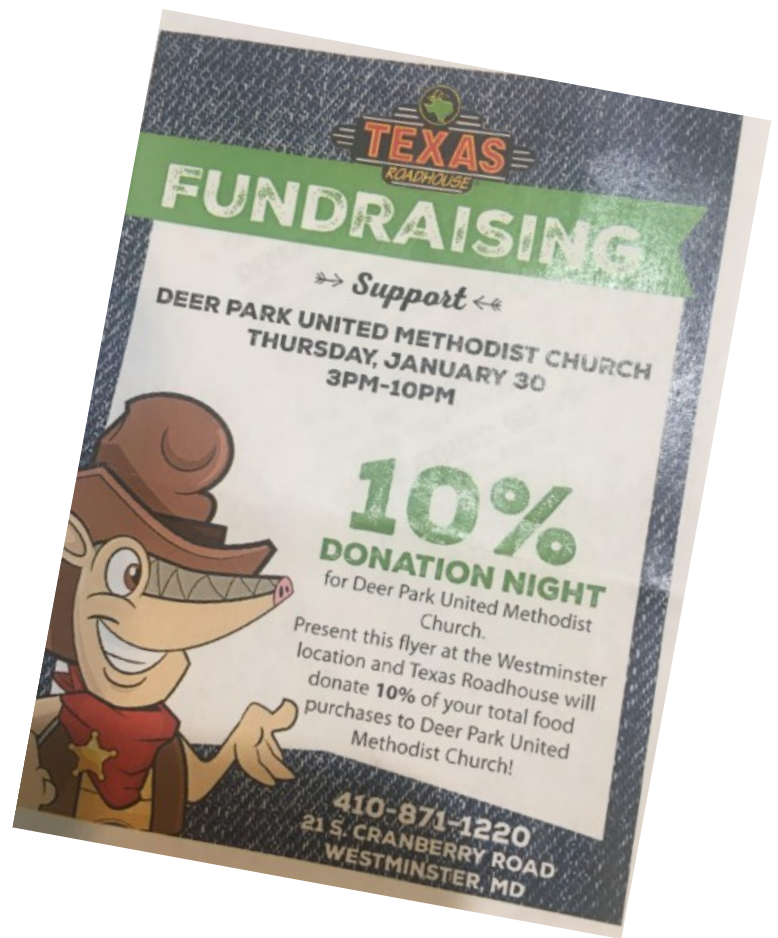
"SOUPER" BOWL X 1st Quarter Update

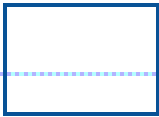
