Dear Prayer Partners,

It is already time for the final prayer letter of the year. We want to leave you with two stories of how God is working, both of which are very new and will be highlights for our family from 2020...

Thai ministry in Switzerland: Through a regional prayer time in August, I (Lanette) heard how to use social media to provide accountability and explanations for daily Bible reading. After investigating with the Thai leaders here, we decided to advertise and get a small group together to read one chapter of the New Testament per day. In all honesty, the three of us didn't have much hope for a group beyond about 5 ladies. We decided to start reading the book of Matthew on December 1st and low and behold, God has graced us with 23 ladies! Now on Day 5, four ladies are not yet engaged, but we will pray for them and the other 19 who are connecting regularly. May God help each one to be led by His Holy Spirit to discover truths from His Word and apply them to their lives. We want to see lives changed - heart change, not just head knowledge. Please pray!

New apartment: One of our friends had been searching for a new apartment for over a year because her building is to be torn down. She received notice to move out by December 1st. With limited income and physical challenges, finding a new place looked impossible from a human standpoint. Each time she applied for something, it was given to someone else. Our (almost late) God decided to give her a small, but modern apartment during the first week of November. After such a long road of prayer and uncertainty, she now is happily getting settled. She even has great neighbors who are helping her get set-up. Praise God for His excellent provision!

Christoph will of course be coordinating the year-end financial work at OMF Switzerland. The financial closure, the insurance and social benefits reporting, all the donor thank you notes - these things all have to be completed within a small time window.

Lydia started her March exams preparation and is looking forward to some time off over the Christmas and New Year's holiday. She hopes some of her friends will be around to hang out with - if not, we want to know where they are?!?

I am thankful for all the great teamwork we have had with the Thai ministry, the Sunday School program and all BSF online meetings. In many ways, God has helped bind me and my co-workers together even though we are almost always separated physically. Praise Him!

May you and your family experience God's amazing grace and peace this Christmas season! Thank you for all of your prayers! We eagerly await what God has for us in 2021! Big hugs, Lanette, Christoph and Lydia
