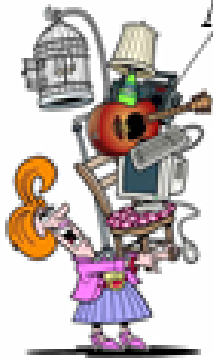
Please consider donating items to our Bazaar Bake Table.
