We at Deer Park UM Church are excited to tell you about our upcoming Vacation Bible School program, so please mark June 20 - June 24, 2022 on your calendar. Our program is for ages 3 years through and including those entering 6th grade. You won't want your children to miss

the fun!

Our program is called "Knights of North Castle: Quest for the King's Armor" and will be hosted by the Armorer and Sparky the Dragon Puppet who is very funny. Each evening they will use humor and fun to lay the foundation for the session's activities during the opening assembly and then reinforce what the children have learned from each session in the closing assembly.
